

RULES AND REGULATIONS

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith"

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES, PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NON MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS, UPON PAYMENT OF A \$20.00 NON MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5.00 BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK-TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES 7) NHRA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; FEDERATION, 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION, AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to intercept all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current USEF/USHJA membership card or copy thereof, or he/she must sign an affidavit and pay a **\$5.00** fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries.

USEF Entry Agreement

By entering a USEF licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of USEF ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. (See GR 908.4).

LIABILITY/LOSS/INJURY

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold the show and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT

If the **courtesy circle** is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified. **Jumping orders will be computer drawn and posted at the in-gate.** Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order.

PROFESSIONALS -- Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitor numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

PARENTS – If not accompanying minor, please send permission for medical treatment (responsibility for care) with trainer or responsible adult.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

DECLARE ALL CLASSES BY 5:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE CLASSES ARE HELD. A TRANSACTION FEE OF \$10.00 PER CLASS WILL BE CHARGED IF CHANGES ARE MADE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CLASSES ARE HELD. ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS IN WHICH THEY HAVE NOT BEEN ENTERED WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY DOUBLE THE ENTRY FEE IN THOSE CLASSES.

ALL TRAINERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON CHECK IN.

SCHOOLING

All schooling sessions will be supervised. All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. **POLING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**

ATTENTION-----ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

STABLING

Stalls shall be assigned as requests are received. Please be advised that show management **cannot guarantee availability of stalls after September 15, 2008.** No refunds unless stalls are canceled by September 15, 2008. All stalls have fronts. First bedding is not included in stabling fees. Barns are not heated. Hay, feed and bedding is purchased from the fairgrounds. **Plan ahead and order in advance. Special orders may require up to 24 hours to deliver and all items may not be available. Please call Barb Ahrens with your advance orders -- 763 477 6023. PLEASE NOTE -- Our contract does not allow us access to the barns or arenas until after 12:30 p.m. on Monday. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please contact Barb Ahrens – 763 477 6023 for earlier overnight stabling in the Minneapolis area. **No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. “SHIPPERS” will be charged a stall fee, a \$50.00 Non Showing Fee and Office/Facility Fee.

HORSE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation recognized competitions (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Horse ID Number from The Federation. An identification number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for recognized competitions. Only one Horse ID Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Horse ID Number may be subject to disciplinary action. Applications for Horse ID Numbers are available from the Federation office, and/or can be downloaded from the Federation website or from competition management. There will be no charge for Horse ID Numbers that are issued via the internet to members of USEF or its affiliates for: 1) horses that are life recorded, registered or otherwise identified or listed with USEF discipline affiliate, or 2) horses registered with a USEF breed affiliate. Horses not meeting the above criteria must have a completed Horse Identification Form submitted with the application for a Horse ID Number before a number will be issued. Horse ID numbers issued via mail or at the horse show will be charged \$10. **See USEF Rule GR 1101.1**

USEF Rule GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle on the grounds of a recognized competition. This includes, but is not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters and farm utility vehicles. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parents or guardians, and/or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter VII. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

Entries postmarked after September 15 will be charged late entries.

Entries postmarked after September 15, 2008 will be considered late entries and a one time late fee of \$50.00 per horse will be charged. Post entries close at the start of the preceding class. **The office will accept no entries on Sunday after 9:00 a.m.** Same horse ineligible to enter both split portions of a section. Show office hours on Monday will be 2:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. On Tuesday through Sunday, the office will open at 7:00 a.m. and close one half hour after the show, with the exception of closing Saturday night during the Grand Prix.

TRAINER SPLITS

Midstates Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

Please Note: Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split. **Reception tickets may be included in trainer splits.**

REFUNDS

PASSES

Exhibitor passes will be required on Friday and Saturday evenings. They can be picked up at the sponsors office.

DOG OWNERS FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE MAY BE SUBJECT TO PENALTY UNDER CHAPTERS 6 & 7, AS WELL AS ISSUANCE OF WARNING CARDS. NO DOGS OR OTHER PETS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE COLESIUM

SMOKING IN THE HORSE BARN AND COLESIUM IS PROHIBITED.

Eight ribbons will be offered in every class, unless specified. Championships and reserve will be awarded according to GR 808 and HU 138.1 for hunter and JP 110 for jumper divisions.

JUMPER TIES FOR OTHER THAN FIRST PLACE WILL HAVE TIME BE THE DECIDING FACTOR.

Amount of prize money awarded in the class is stated right after the class number in specifications of the section. See schedule below. Premium checks may be picked up at the secretary's office when you are ready to leave and when your bill has been paid in full. However, management reserves the right to mail checks after the conclusion of the horse show. **Premiums can be subtracted from payment due.**

OPEN JUNIOR EQUITATION

Class Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. For 11/Under – fences not to exceed 2’6”, no combinations and tests 1-8 may be used; for 12-14 years – fences not to exceed 3’ and tests 1-18 may be used; for 15-17 years – fences not to exceed 3’6” and tests 1-19 may be used.

Class 7 **Adult Amateur Equitation**

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to non professional riders who have reached their 18th birthday. Fences not to exceed 3’. Tests 1-8 may be required.

Class 8 **Minnesota Harvest Junior Equitation Class**

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to all juniors. Fences 3’6”. Course to be a standard hunter course, numeric scoring system to be used.

Class 9 **MHJA Hunt Seat Medal (2009 Qualifier)**

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to junior and amateur riders, who are current members of the MHJA. Application for membership must be made directly to the MHJA. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles not to exceed 3’ in height which must include one combination and one change of direction and one long approach to a fence. Two or more tests of the top four riders are required, one of which must be test 8, an oral question. Tests 1-14. Only one rider per horse. Amateur riders in this class may cross enter into classes where fences are 3’6” or higher. Junior Riders in this class may not cross enter, at the same show, into classes where fences are 3’6” or higher unless they are in their first year of showing over fences 3’6” or higher, except for the Medal Final class, where they may cross enter if otherwise qualified. First through fourth place winners shall be eligible to compete in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal Final. The final for this class may be held at a horse show to be announced at the beginning of the year. For the MHJA medal final, there will be four phases: a written exam, a practical exam, a flat phase and an over fences phase. If an exhibitor does not wish to participate in the written and practical exams they will receive no score for those phases. The written and practical exams will each count 15% of the total score, the flat phase 35% and the over fences phase 35%. No tests shall be required at the Finals unless exhibitors scores are tied, and the judge deems it necessary to break the tie. The winner of the final will receive a perpetual trophy. In the event no final class is held, the perpetual trophy shall be awarded to the rider who has accumulated the most points in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal class throughout the year.

Open to junior riders on Children's Ponies. Fences will be set at Children's Hunter Pony heights. 2' Fences 2' for Small/Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies.

All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise specified.

LIMIT CHILDREN'S WORKING HUNTER

Class Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors who have not won more than six blue ribbons at a USEF rated show. Ribbons won in the pony hunter sections or won over fences 2'9" and lower not to count. Riders shall remain eligible for the entire season. Fences not to exceed 2'9".

Class 16,17 Limit Children's Hunter Over Fences

Class 18 Limit Children's Hunter Under Saddle

LIMIT ADULT WORKING HUNTER

Class Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to riders no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor. Amateur certification required. Open to riders who have not won six (6) first place ribbons over fences 3' or higher at any USEF/CEF recognized competition, including equitation, in the last six (6) years. A rider who is eligible as of December 1 shall retain their eligibility for the entire year, regardless of ribbons won. Horse/Rider combinations entered in Limit Adult may not cross enter into Low Amateur Hunter classes, or any class where the height of fences exceeds 3'. Riders may, however, enter into the Low Amateur Hunter on a different mount. To be judged on performance and soundness, with emphasis on manners. Not to jog for ribbons. Height of Fences 2'9".

Class 19,20 Limit Adult Hunter Over Fences

Class 21 Limit Adult Hunter Under Saddle

LOW AMATEUR HUNTERClass Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to amateur riders no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor. Amateur certification required. Horse/Rider combinations entered in Low Amateur may not cross enter into Limit Adult, or into classes where the height of the fences exceeds 3'6". Riders may, if otherwise qualified, enter the Limit Adult on a different mount. Riders may also enter classes where the height of fences exceeds 3'6" on another mount. To be judged on performance and soundness, with emphasis on manners. Height of fences 2'9" – 3'. Entries not to jog for ribbons. If there are 30 or more entries at the start of the division, management must split the division and award two sets of ribbons and two championships.

NON PRO HUNTERClass Entry Fee: \$ 35.00

Open to all non professional riders. No cross entry restrictions. Fences 3'

LOW AMATEUR-OWNER HUNTERClass Entry Fee: \$35.00

To be ridden by an Amateur-Owner or an amateur member of the owners family. Leased horses are not eligible and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all owners are members of the same family. Horse/Rider combinations may not compete in the Adult Amateur Division at the same show. Fences 3'3". Amateur certification required.

Class 28,29,30 Low Amateur-Owner Hunter Over Fences
Class 31 Low Amateur-Owner Hunter Under Saddle

LONG STIRRUP HUNTERClass Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to horses or ponies. Open to junior and amateur riders who have not won three (3) first place ribbons at any USEF/CEF recognized show over fences which exceed 2'9" in height in the past three years, including equitation. No rider may cross enter, at the same show, between this division and short stirrup hunter/equitation. Junior riders in this division may not cross enter into classes where the height of fences exceed 3'. Adult Amateur riders in this division may not cross enter into classes where fences exceed 2'9" Fences not to exceed 2'6". Combinations prohibited. Manners emphasized. Extreme speed to be penalized.

Open to any horse. Fences to be 3'- 3'3". To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Each competitor will jump one round of approximately 10 fences.
