

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, the horse show management shall settle any dispute or question and the decision shall be final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition of admission, shall consent to such methods of settlement. GR 1401.9 states that:

**LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS, UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK-TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NHRA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS, WHO HAVE PROOF IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.**

### **USEF Entry Agreement**

By entering a USEF licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of USEF ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes/ to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold Midstates Horse Shows, LLC, the North Iowa Fairgrounds and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF Federation and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF Federation. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

**DOG OWNERS** USEF GR1301. 6. **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE LOOSE ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS AND MUST BE ON A LEASH OR OTHERWISE CONTAINED. INDIVIDUALS MUST NOT LEAD DOGS ON A LEASH WHILE MOUNTED. DOG OWNERS FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE MAY BE SUBJECT TO PENALTY UNDER CHAPTERS 6 & 7, AS WELL AS ISSUANCE OF WARNING CARDS.**

**PARKING** **NO PARKING IN FIRE LANES** Show management reserves the right to ask anyone to move their cars, trucks, trailers and vans at any time.

**GOLF CARTS** Golf carts will be available. A lease agreement must be signed. Please call ahead to reserve one. **The supply is limited. Please reserve one early.**

**CONCESSIONS** Crow River Catering will again be serving food on the grounds.

**REFUNDS** Prior to arrival on the show grounds, entry fees shall be refunded if horse/rider is unable to participate. Stall fees shall not be refunded after closing date.

**LUNGEING** Lungeing is permitted in designated areas. No lungeing on the grass anywhere on the horse show grounds

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and animals to stalls, buildings and any other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

## RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT

If the **courtesy circle** is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified. **Jumping orders will be posted at the in-gate. Jumping orders will be pre-posted and rolled.** Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order. **Please advise the paddock master of any conflicts.**

## MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$30 (or \$60 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable non member fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries

## ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

**DECLARE ALL CLASSES BY 5:00 P.M.** THE DAY BEFORE CLASSES ARE HELD. A **TRANSACTION FEE OF \$10.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET** WILL BE CHARGED IF CHANGES ARE MADE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CLASSES ARE HELD. **ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS IN WHICH THEY HAVE NOT BEEN ENTERED WILL BE CHARGED A \$25.00 RODE WITHOUT ENTERING CHARGE.**

**ALL TRAINERS ARE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE AT CHECK IN.**

**In order to insure your entry blanks are received before secretary leaves for Iowa DO NOT mail entry blanks later than April 19 for Spring Show, May 20 for Summer Shows and Sept. 1 for Fall Shows. To avoid late fees, entries must be mailed by closing dates.**

**TRAINER SPLITS**

Midstates Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment. **Please Note:** Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split.

**ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER CLOSING DATE FOR EACH SHOW WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE ENTRIES AND A ONE TIME LATE FEE OF \$50.00 PER HORSE WILL BE CHARGED.** Post entries close at the start of the preceding class. **“Shippers will be charged a stall, Non Showing and office/facility fee. THE OFFICE WILL ACCEPT NO ENTRIES ON SUNDAY AFTER 9:00 A.M.** Same horse ineligible to enter both split portions of a section. Show office hours on Tuesday will be 10:00 – 7:00 p.m. On Wednesday through Sunday, office hours are 7:00 a.m. until show closes, unless otherwise notified.

**FEED & BEDDING:** Feed and bedding is available through the horse show office. For deliveries prior to arrival, please call the horse show office at 641 424 3547. Exhibitors who bring their own shavings will be charged a \$25.00 per horse disposal fee.

**PROFESSIONALS** --Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitors numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

**PARENTS** – If not accompanying minor, please send permission for medical treatment (responsibility for care) with trainer or responsible adult.

## HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Horse Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or the USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at [www.ushja.org](http://www.ushja.org) or [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org) using the Horse Registration application form. The Horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website of from competition management. **See USEF Rules EQ100, HU 100, HB100, HP 100, JH 100 and JP100.**

## SCHOOLING

All schooling sessions will be supervised. When mounted, all riders must wear protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Schooling Hours:

Tuesday: 11:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.

Wednesday - Saturday

(Arenas will close 45 minutes prior to show time)

**SUNDAY: THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOLING IN ANY ARENAS.**

All arenas will be open for schooling during posted hours beginning at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday preceding the show. **Schooling in Grand Prix Ring may be limited.**

## STABLING

Stalls are temporary inside permanent barns. All stalls have fronts. First bedding is not included in the stabling fee. **No refunds** unless stalls are canceled by closing date of each horse show. Barns will be open on Monday preceding the show at noon. Barns will close on Monday after the show at 10:00 a.m. **No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. ## GOLF CARTS AND MOTORIZED VEHICLES

USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle on the grounds of a recognized competition. This includes, but is not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters and farm utility vehicles. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) or guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Rule 6. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

## ATTENTION-----ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

**It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.**

Championships and reserve will be awarded according to GR 808, for hunter, JP 110.2 for jumper and equitation divisions. **JUMPER TIES FOR OTHER THAN FIRST PLACE WILL HAVE TIME BE THE DECIDING FACTOR.** Amount of prize money awarded in the class is stated right after the class number in specifications of the section. See schedule below. Premium checks may be picked up at the secretary's office when you are ready to leave and when your bill has been paid in full. However, management reserves the right to mail checks after the conclusion of the horse show. **Premiums can be subtracted from payment due.**

**SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION**

Class Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to junior riders who have not reached their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday and have not won six first place ribbons over fences 2'6" or higher. A rider who is eligible as of December 1, shall retain his/her eligibility throughout the year regardless of ribbons won. No rider may cross enter, at the same show, between the Short Stirrup hunter/equitation and the Long Stirrup hunter/equitation sections or between short stirrup hunter/equitation and any class requiring the entry to jump 3' or higher. Open to horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 2'3". Manners emphasized and extreme speed penalized. Combinations and oxers prohibited. In Flat Classes, no more than 8 entries to canter at one time, and no hand gallop.

**LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION**

Class Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to horses or ponies. Open to junior and amateur riders who have not won three (3) first place ribbons at any USEF/CEF recognized show over fences which exceed 2'9" in height in the past three years, including equitation. No rider may cross enter, at the same show, between this division and short stirrup hunter/equitation. Junior riders in this division may not cross enter into classes where the height of fences exceed 3'. Adult Amateur riders in this division may not cross enter into classes where fences exceed 2'9". Fences not to exceed 2'6". Combinations prohibited. Manners emphasized. Extreme speed to be penalized.

## **SHORTEST STIRRUP EQUITATION, OPPORTUNITY DIVISION** Sponsored by St. Croix Saddlery

Class Entry Fee: \$10.00

Open to junior riders who have not reached their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday. Riders in this division may not cross enter into any other division or class at the same horse show, except classes on the flat and under saddle classes for which they are otherwise eligible. Equitation Classes may consist of unmounted showmanship, walk-trot, walk-trot-canter and crossrails. Crossrail courses shall be twice around the ring on the rail, with no diagonal lines. Trotting not to be penalized in crossrail class. In flat/under saddle classes, no more than 6 entries to canter at one time. Manners emphasized and extreme speed to be penalized. All shortest stirrup classes, both Equitation and Hunter, shall be counted equally for one year end award. ***Entries in Shortest Stirrup are not required to have USEF/USHJA membership or pay the non member fee, and their horse or pony need not be registered with USHJA or recorded with USEF to participate in these classes. Entries are required to pay all other fees. If riders or horses enter in any other classes at the show, they ARE required to have all necessary memberships and registrations.*** To be eligible for the MHJA year end award in this division, the rider must be an active member of the MHJA.

**YOUNG JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR 5, 6 & 7/8 YEAR OLDS (Spring, Summerfest & Summer Only)**

The Young Jumper Championship program has been organized to provide an opportunity for tomorrow's Grand Prix horses to compete in a meaningful competition against their peers. Offered for five and six year old horses that are recorded with the YJC. Qualifying classes are held at shows throughout the country. Competing successfully in these qualifying classes is a prerequisite for competing in the league finals of the YJC, to be held on both the east and west coast, in late summer. The host events of the league finals will be given the right to restrict entries to not less than the top thirty horses in each age group on the basis of their best six placings in YJC qualifying classes. Horses will also begin the league finals with one score obtained from the horse's best three first round fault scores from qualifying classes. See the Young Jumpers Championship website at **WWW.YOUNGJUMPERS.COM** for complete program rules, application for YJC recording, show applications, calendar of shows offering YJC classes, and for competition results throughout the season. Horses not previously recorded may apply at the show office for YJC recording upon presentation of the horse's breed registry papers (that indicate the sire, dam, sire of dam, foaling date and description of the horse) and payment of the \$100 recording fee. The recording fee makes the horse eligible to enter all YJC events. USEF schooling rules will be enforced. Draw reins, poling and the use of off-sets will not be allowed. FEI schooling rules will apply.

**CLASS 364 YJC QUALIFYING CLASS - 5 YEAR OLDS** Entry Fee: \$40.00

Open to horses foaled in 2004, and recorded with the YJA. Table V with optimum time used to decide the placings, i.e. horses equal on the basis of jumping and time faults will break ties on the basis of the time closest to the time allowed in the jump-off being declared the winner, etc.) **Spring Show 1.15 m – Summerfest & Summer Shows 1.20 m.**

**CLASS 365 \$500 YJC QUALIFYING CLASS - 6 YEAR OLDS** Entry Fee: \$50.00

Open to horses foaled in 2003, and recorded with the YJC. Table II, Section 2.2 (a/b). Time first jump off. **Spring Show 1.20 m Summerfest & Summer Shows 1.30 m.**

**CLASS 366 \$500 YJC QUALIFYING CLASS – 7 & 8 YEAR OLDS** Entry Fee: \$50.00

Open to horses foaled in 2001 & 2002 and recorded with the YJC. Table II, Section 2.2 (a/b). Time first jump off. **Spring Show 7 Yr. Olds to jump 1.30 m – 8 Yr. Olds to jump 1.35 m. Summer & Summerfest Horse Shows – 7 Yr. Olds to Jump 1.35 m – 8 Yr. Olds to jump 1.35 m.**

## **USHJA ZONE VI ZANDRA POWERS MEMORIAL HORSEMANSHIP CLASSIC**

The Classic is open to Amateur and Junior riders who are active members of the USEF/USHJA Zone VI. To be run in two sections, one at 3'6" in height and one at 3' in height. Riders may enter only one section, even if qualified for both. Qualification period shall be from September 1 to August 31. Each section to be judged separately and have its own ribbons and trophies. Zone members may qualify for the Classic at shows held outside Zone VI, but they must be Zone VI members to be eligible to participate in the Classic.

Both sections of the Classic will have a written test phase and a riding phase. The written phase will be held prior to the riding phase. Should an exhibitor not wish to participate in the written exam, they will receive no score for that phase. The written exam will be numerically scored and will be the starting score at the beginning of the riding phase. The score for the initial riding phase will be added to the score for the written phase for a numerical score. The top 50% of the class by numerical score must be called back to test. The tests shall be at the judge's discretion. The judge may request a flat phase of the top 50% if so, the judge must further individually test the top four contestants after the flat phase. The written exam will include questions on horse shows, horse care, equipment and the horse, and riding techniques. Sources used may include the USEF rule book, George Morris' *Hunt Seat Equitation*, Paul Cronin's *Riding and Training the Sport Horse*, and the Pony Club manuals.

**Class 418 – 3'6" Section** – Open to junior or amateur Zone VI riders who have won a first, second or third place in any National Medal Class where the height of fences is 3'6" or higher, This includes, but is not limited to: USEF Hunt Seat Medal Class, ASPCA Horsemanship Class, USEF Show Jumping Talent Search, WIHS Class, Marshall & Sterling Central Equine Junior Medal. The course must consist of at least eight obstacles 3'6" in height and follow USEF EQ.111.10. USEF tests 1-19.

**Class 419 – 3' Section** – Open to junior or amateur Zone VI riders who have won a first, second or third place in the following classes where the height of fences is 3'-3'3". Medal classes offered by any of the Zone VI Affiliate organizations – MHJA, INHJA, or WHJA; or any nationally recognized Medal class at that height, such as Marshall & Sterling Charles Owens, USEF Adult Equitation Class etc. Amateur riders who qualify for this section may opt to ride in the 3'6" section if they so desire. The course must consist of 8 or more obstacles 3' in height and follow USEF EQ.110.10 USEF tests 1-14.

**All participants who enter in the USHJA Zone VI Championship Classics must be members of Zone VI, either current senior, junior or life members of USHJA and all horse/ponies must be currently recorded with USEF. These special classes have individual entry fees. These classes will be held at the Midstates Fall Horse Show only.**

**Special points will be given in the Zone VI Championship classes. Points are as follows: 1.5 times the points normally awarded for Champion, Reserve, and third through sixth place in each respective class. Also, 1.5 times the normal points will be given for Classics.**

**The first round of the Zone VI hunter classics will be combined with the second class of the respective section on the second day of the division, except for class 400 & 401, Children's Zone VI, which will be held in its entirety on Sunday. Formal attire to be worn. First through eighth place ribbons will be given. Riders to ride for ribbons. Jumper championships will be held simultaneously with the largest money class in their respective division.**
