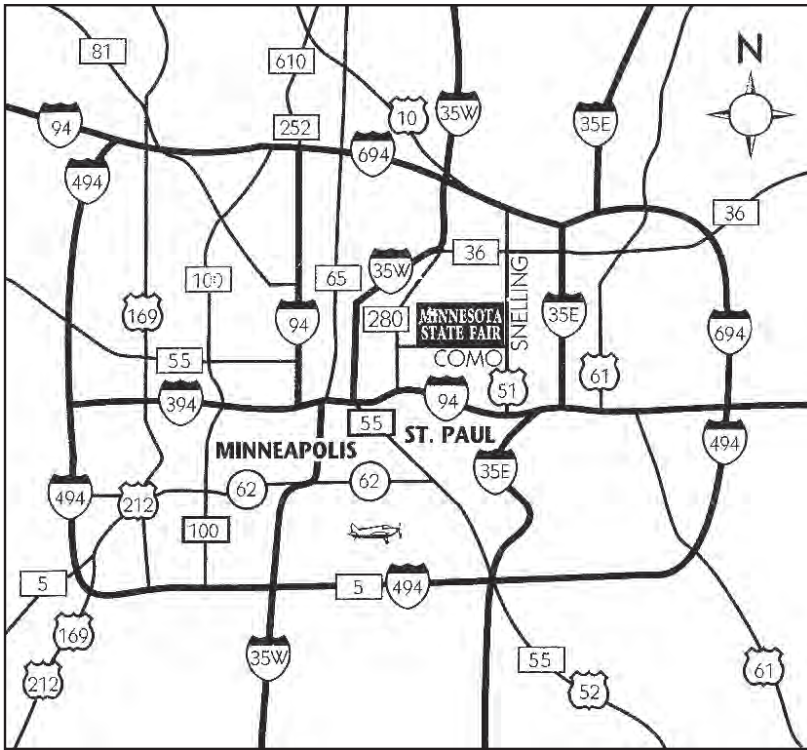

# GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

*Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.*

## USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. *EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08*

## USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a USEF licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of USEF ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those

likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize Amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. (See GR 908.4).

## LIABILITY/LOSS/INJURY

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, vendors, sub-contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold the show and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to intercept all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

## MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the Competition Secretary a current USEF/USHJA membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$30 (or \$60 if both USEF and USHJA) non-refundable non-member fee. All Junior and Pony Hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All Amateur-Owners and Adult Amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. **To speed processing, please enclose photocopies of these cards with entries.**

## STABLING

Stalls will be assigned as requests are received. **Please be advised that show management cannot guarantee availability of stalls after September 20, 2009. No refunds unless stalls are canceled by September 20, 2009.** All stalls have fronts. First bedding is *not* included in stabling fees. Barns are *not* heated. Hay, feed and bedding is purchased from the fairgrounds. Plan ahead and order in advance. Special orders may require up to 24 hours to deliver and all items may not be available. Please call Barb Ahrens with your advance orders -- 763.477.6023. **PLEASE NOTE** — *Our contract does not allow us access to the barns or arenas until after 12:30 p.m. on Monday. NO EXCEPTIONS.* Please contact Barb Ahrens – 763.477.6023 for earlier overnight stabling in the Minneapolis area. No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. **ALL HORSES SHOWING OR NON-SHOWING WILL BE CHARGED A STALL FEE.** Be sure to add stabling information to entry form. Shippers will be charged a stall fee, a \$50.00 Non-Showing Fee and an Office/Facility Fee.

## HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Horse Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or the USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at [www.ushja.org](http://www.ushja.org) or [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org) using the Horse Registration application form. The horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. See USEF Rules EQ100, HU100, HB100, HP100, JH100 and JP100.

## MOTORIZED VEHICLES

USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle on the grounds of a recognized competition. This includes, but is not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters and farm utility vehicles. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parents or guardians, and/or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter VII. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

NOTE: Golf carts are not allowed on fair grounds.

# GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

## RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT

If the courtesy circle is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified. **Jumping orders will be computer drawn and posted at the in-gate.** Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order.

**Professionals** — Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitor numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

**Parents** — If not accompanying minor, please send permission for medical treatment (responsibility for care) with trainer or responsible adult.

## ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

Declare all classes by 5:00 p.m. the day before classes are held. A transaction fee of \$10.00 per add/scratch sheet will be charged if changes are made on the same day as the classes are held. Any entry riding in a class in which they have not been entered will be charged a \$25.00 Rode Without Entering charge.

All trainers will be required to leave an open check in the horse show office upon check in.

## SCHOOLING

All schooling sessions will be supervised. All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. **POLING IS NOT PERMITTED.**

**Monday:** 4:00 p.m. — 10:30 p.m.

**Tuesday-Sunday:** Schooling times will be posted in the Horse Show Office

*Please note: the arena will close 30-minutes prior to show time.*

## ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition

grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show committee member must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

## FEE SCHEDULE

# GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Entries postmarked after September 20, 2009 will be considered late entries and a one time late fee of \$50.00 per horse will be charged. Post entries close at the start of the preceding class. The office will accept no entries on Sunday after 9:00 a.m. Same horse ineligible to enter both split portions of a section. Show office hours:

**Monday:** 2:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

**Tuesday - Sunday:** 7:00 a.m. – 1/2 hour after the show

**Saturday Night:** Closed during the Grand Prix

Proof of negative coggins required for all horses within 12 months. This must be presented before numbers will be given out. This is a Minnesota state law.

## TRAINER SPLITS

Midstates Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

*Please note: Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split. **Reception tickets may be included in trainer splits.***

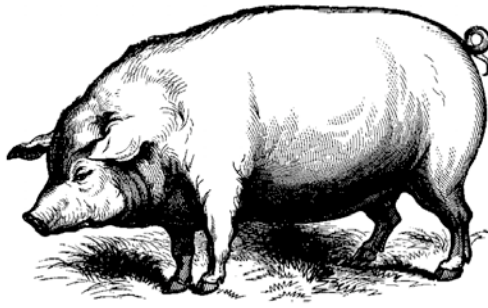

Two or more tests of the top four riders are required, one of which must be test 8, an oral question. Tests 1-14. Only one rider per horse. Junior Riders in this class may not cross enter, at the same show, into classes where fences are 3'6" or higher unless they are in their first year of showing over fences 3'6" or higher, except for the Medal Final class, where they may cross enter if otherwise qualified. First through fourth place winners shall be eligible to compete in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal Final. The final for this class may be held at a horse show to be announced at the beginning of the year. For the

MHJA medal final, there will be four phases: a written exam, a practical exam, a flat phase and an over fences phase. If an exhibitor does not wish to participate in the written and practical exams they will receive no score for those phases. The written and practical exams will each count 15% of the total score, the flat phase 35% and the over fences phase 35%. No tests shall be required at the Finals unless exhibitors scores are tied, and the judge deems it necessary to break the tie. The winner of the final will receive a perpetual trophy. In the event no final class is held, the perpetual trophy shall be awarded to the rider who has accumulated the most points in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal class throughout the year.

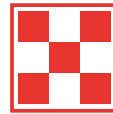

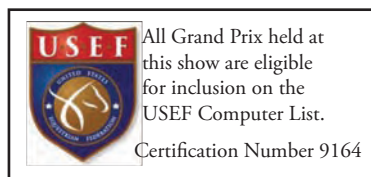
