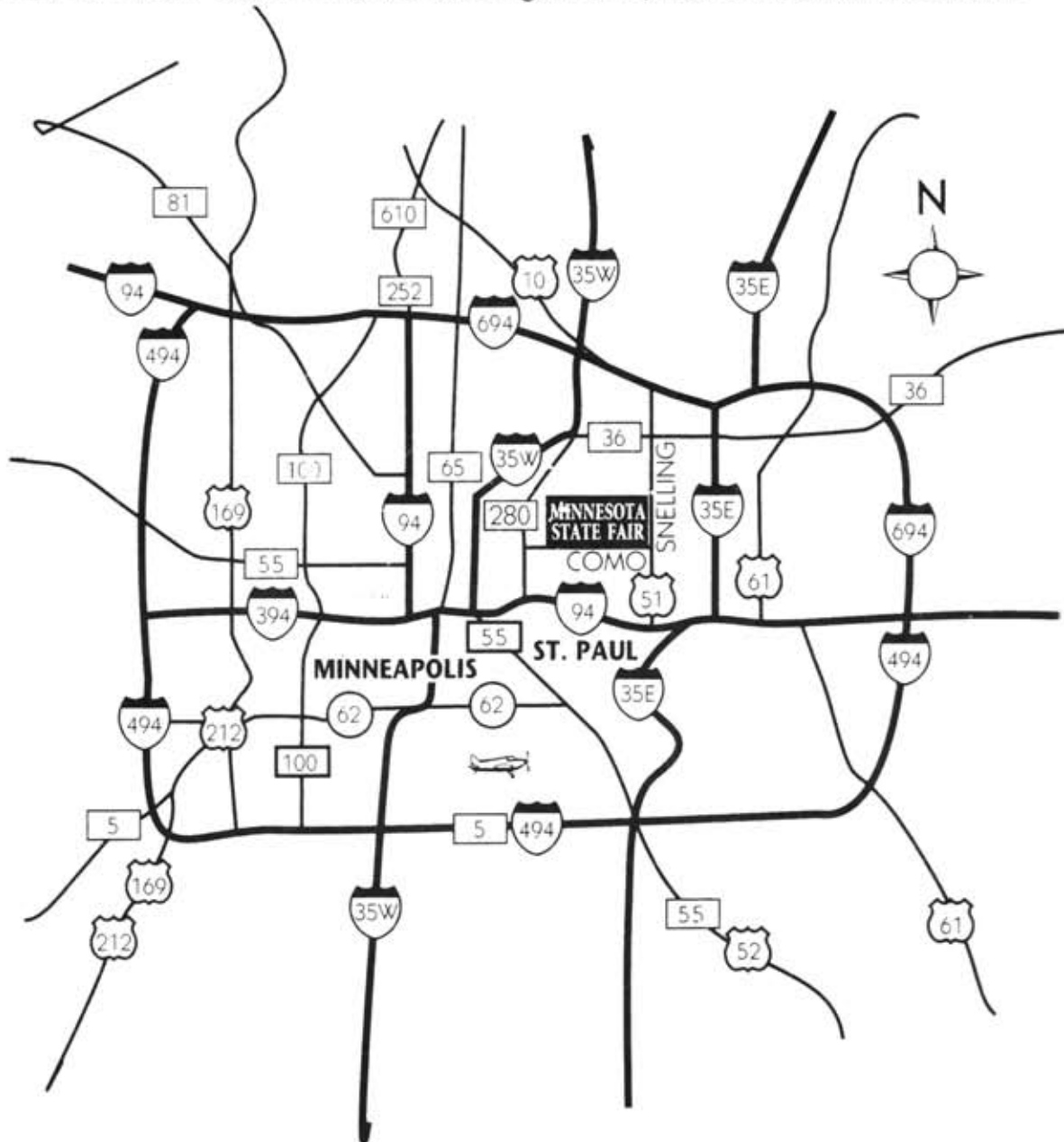
DIRECTIONS TO THE MINNESOTA STATE FAIRGROUNDS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH"

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS, UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK-TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NHRA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS, WHO HAVE PROOF IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to intercept all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$30 (or \$60 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable non member fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries.

USEF Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (“the Federation”) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

LIABILITY/LOSS/INJURY

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold the show and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT

If the **courtesy circle** is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified. **Jumping orders will be computer drawn and posted at the in-gate.** Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order.

PROFESSIONALS -- Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitor numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

PARENTS – If not accompanying minor, please send permission for medical treatment (responsibility for care) with trainer or responsible adult.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

DECLARE ALL CLASSES BY 5:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE CLASSES ARE HELD. A TRANSACTION FEE OF \$10.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET WILL BE CHARGED IF CHANGES ARE MADE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CLASSES ARE HELD. ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS IN WHICH THEY HAVE NOT BEEN ENTERED WILL BE CHARGED A \$25.00 RODE WITHOUT ENTERING CHARGE.

SCHOOLING

All schooling sessions will be supervised. All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. **POLING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**

ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

STABLING

Stalls shall be assigned as requests are received. Please be advised that show management **cannot guarantee availability of stalls after September 20, 2011**. No refunds unless stalls are canceled by September 20, 2011. All stalls have fronts. First bedding is not included in stabling fees. Barns are not heated. Hay, feed and bedding is purchased from the fairgrounds. **Plan ahead and order in advance. Special orders may require up to 24 hours to deliver and all items may not be available. Please call Barb Ahrens with your advance orders -- 763 477 6023. PLEASE NOTE -- Our contract does not allow us access to the barns or arenas until after 12:30 p.m. on Monday. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please contact Barb Ahrens – 763 477 6023 for earlier overnight stabling in the Minneapolis area. **No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. “SHIPPERS” will be charged a stall fee, a \$50.00 Non Showing Fee and Office Fee.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-11 must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Horse Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or the USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. The Horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. **Horses must still be recorded with the USEF (either Lifetime or Annual) to receive National or Zone points** See USEF Rules EQ 100.2, HU 101.1, And JP101.2.

MEDICAL WASTE

Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles are provided for disposal of hypodermic needles in aisle of barns. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 fine. Please do not mix with manure waste or trash cans.

HORSE/PONY MEASUREMENTS:

Times for Horse/Pony Measurements will be posted in the horse show office.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) or guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

TRAINER SPLITS

Midstates Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

Please Note: Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split. Reception tickets may be included in trainer splits.

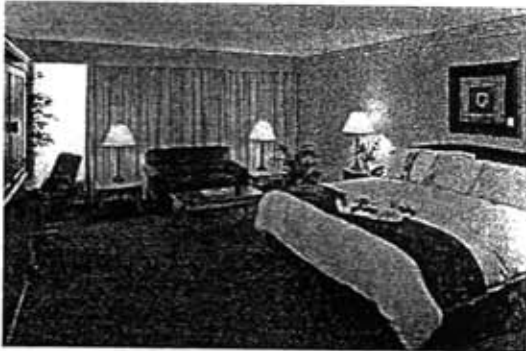

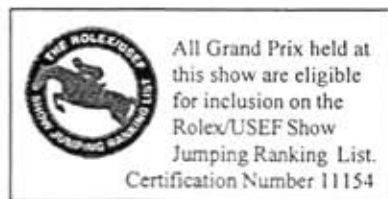

In each case, it will be this combination on which he/she will earn points. For riders who do not designate their Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List horse prior to the start order being determined, his/her Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List horse will be the first horse he/she rides in the class. If a rider scratches his Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List horse before the start of the class, the next horse he/she is scheduled to ride in the class will move into this place in the jumping order, and will become his Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List horse. Horses competing in this class must be recorded with the USEF. USEF Rule GR207 requires all horses competing in this class to pay a \$35.00 IHP fee.
