RULES AND REGULATIONS

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, the horse show management shall settle any dispute or question and the decision shall be final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition of admission, shall consent to such methods of settlement. GR 901.9 states that:

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS, UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK-TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NHRA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS, WHO HAVE PROOF IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

USEF Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

The horse show management reserves the right to itself, to refuse, limit, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors thereby canceling awarded prizes/ to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to change rings or officials, to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants and to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind.

LIABILITY/LOSS/INJURY

Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold Midstates Horse Shows, LLC, the North Iowa Fairgrounds and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF Federation and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF Federation. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

DOG OWNERS USEF GR1301. 6. **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE LOOSE ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS AND MUST BE ON A LEASH OR OTHERWISE CONTAINED. INDIVIDUALS MUST NOT LEAD DOGS ON A LEASH WHILE MOUNTED. DOG OWNERS ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES, CLAIMS, LOSSES, OR ACTIONS RESULTING FROM THEIR DOGS' BEHAVIOR. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

PARKING NO PARKING IN FIRE LANES Show management reserves the right to ask anyone to move their cars, trucks, trailers and vans at any time.

GOLF CARTS Golf carts will be available. A lease agreement must be signed. Please call ahead to reserve one. **The supply is limited. Please reserve one early.**

CONCESSIONS Crow River Catering will again be serving food on the grounds.

REFUNDS Prior to arrival on the show grounds, entry fees shall be refunded if horse/rider is unable to participate. Stall fees shall not be refunded after closing date.

LUNGEING Lungeing is permitted in designated areas. No lungeing on the grass anywhere on the horse show grounds

RESPONSIBILITY: All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and animals to stalls, buildings and any other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

RING/EXHIBITOR CONDUCT

If the **courtesy circle** is restricted, it shall be announced, and also be indicated on the course diagram. A corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena. If said restrictions are not observed, the rider shall be disqualified. **Jumping orders will be posted at the in-gate. Jumping orders will be pre-posted and rolled.** Post entries will be added to the top of the jump order. **Please advise the paddock master of any conflicts.**

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$30 (or \$60 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable non member fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

DECLARE ALL CLASSES BY 5:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE CLASSES ARE HELD. A **TRANSACTION FEE OF \$10.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET** WILL BE CHARGED IF CHANGES ARE MADE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CLASSES ARE HELD. **ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS IN WHICH THEY HAVE NOT BEEN ENTERED WILL BE CHARGED A \$25.00 RODE WITHOUT ENTERING CHARGE.**

ALL TRAINERS ARE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE AT CHECK IN.

In order to insure your entry blanks are received before secretary leaves for Iowa DO NOT mail entry blanks later than April 25 for Spring Show, May 28 for Summer Shows and Sept. 1 for Fall Shows. To avoid late fees, entries must be mailed by closing dates.

TRAINER SPLITS

Midstates Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment. **Please Note:** Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split.

Iowa law requires all horses entering the state have current health certificates and coggins.

ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER CLOSING DATE FOR EACH SHOW WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE ENTRIES AND A ONE TIME LATE FEE OF \$50.00 PER HORSE WILL BE CHARGED. Post entries close at the start of the preceding class. "Shippers will be charged a stall, Non Showing and office/facility fee. **THE OFFICE WILL ACCEPT NO ENTRIES ON SUNDAY AFTER 9:00 A.M.** Same horse ineligible to enter both split portions of a section. Show office hours on Tuesday will be 10:00 – 7:00 p.m. On Wednesday through Sunday, office hours are 7:00 a.m. until show closes, unless otherwise notified.

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding is available through the horse show office. For deliveries prior to arrival, please call the horse show office at 641 424 3547. Exhibitors who bring their own shavings will be charged a \$25.00 per horse disposal fee.

PROFESSIONALS --Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitors numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

PARENTS – If not accompanying minor, please send permission for medical treatment (responsibility for care) with trainer or responsible adult.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-11 must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Horse Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or the USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. The Horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website of from competition management. **HORSES MUST STILL BE RECORDED WITH THE USEF (EITHER LIFETIME OR ANNUAL) TO RECEIVE NATIONAL OR ZONE POINTS. See USEF Rules EQ 100.2, HU 101.1, And JP101.2.**

SCHOOLING

All schooling sessions will be supervised. When mounted, all riders must wear protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Schooling Hours:

Tuesday: 11:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.
Wednesday - Saturday
(Arenas will close 45 minutes prior to show time)
SUNDAY: **THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOLING IN ANY ARENAS.**

All arenas will be open for schooling during posted hours beginning at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday preceding the show. **Schooling in Grand Prix Ring may be limited.**

STABLING

Stalls are temporary inside permanent barns. All stalls have fronts. First bedding is not included in the stabling fee. **No refunds** unless stalls are canceled by closing date of each horse show. Barns will be open on Monday preceding the show at noon. Barns will close on Monday after the show at 10:00 a.m. **No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. Be sure to add stabling information to entry form. Every horse will be charged a stall fee.** Stabling needs????? Call Kris Rame -- 352 875 8446 or Barb Ahrens -- 763 477 6023.

ATTENTION TRAINERS

For every SIX horses entered by each trainer/barn, with deposit checks, on or before the closing date of entries, your Trainer/Barn will receive 1 free stall.

GOLF CARTS AND MOTORIZED VEHICLES

USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) or guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

ATTENTION-----ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

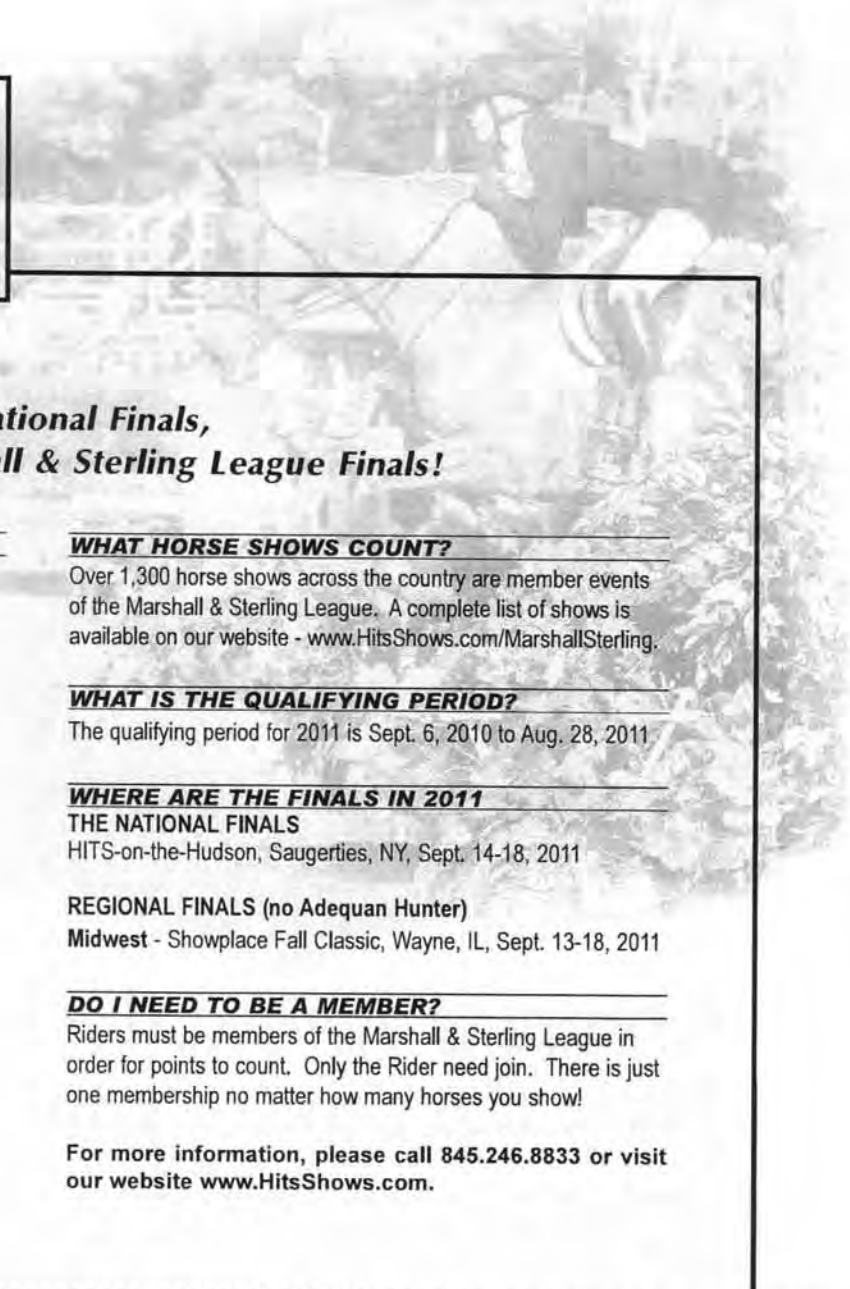

To be shown over a course of not less than 8 obstacles not exceeding 3' in height which must include one combination, one change of direction, and one long approach to a fence. Two or more tests of the top four riders are required, USEF Tests 1-14. Only one rider per horse. Amateur riders in this class may cross enter into classes where fences are 3'6" or higher. Junior riders in this class may not cross enter, at the same show, into classes where fences are 3'6" or higher unless they are in their first year of showing over fences 3'6" or higher; except for the Medal Final class, where they may cross enter if otherwise qualified. First through fourth place winners shall be eligible to compete in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal Final. The final for this class may be held at a horse show to be announced at the beginning of the year. The Final shall consist of a course of not less than 8 obstacles not exceeding 3' in height which must include one combination, one change of direction, and one long approach to a fence. The winner of the final will receive a perpetual trophy. PLEASE NOTE CHANGES

The Championship will be open to Amateur and Junior riders who are active members of the USEF/USHJA Zone VI. To be run in two sections: one at 3'6" in height and one at 3' in height. Riders may enter only one section. Qualification period shall be from September 1 to August 31. Each section to be judged separately and have its own ribbons and trophies. Zone members may qualify for the Championship at shows held outside Zone VI, but they must be Zone VI members to be eligible to participate in the Championship. Both sections of the Championship will have a written test phase and a riding phase. The written phase will be held prior to the riding phase. Should an exhibitor not wish to participate in the written exam, they will receive no score for that phase. The written exam will be numerically scored and will be the starting score at the beginning of the riding phase. The score for the initial riding phase will be added to the score for the written phase for a numerical score. The top 50 % of the class by numerical score will be called back to test. The tests shall be at the judge's discretion. If the judge requests a flat phase of the top 50 % first, they may also request further individual testing of the top four contestants. The courses for the Final shall meet the requirements of USEF Rule EQ111.10. A Liverpool or water is prohibited.

Class 540 3' Section – Open to junior or amateur Zone VI riders who have won a first or second place in the following classes where the height of fences is 3' to 3'3": Medal Classes offered by any of the Zone VI Affiliate organizations – MHJA, INHJA or WHJA; or any nationally recognized Medal class at that height such as M and S Charles Owens, USEF Adult Equitation Class, etc... Amateur riders who qualify for this section may opt to ride in the 3'6" section if they so desire. The course shall consist of not less than 8 obstacles 3' in height and must meet USEF Rule EQ111.10. A Liverpool or water is prohibited. USEF tests 1-14. See above for class procedure

Class 541 3'6" Section – Open to junior or amateur Zone VI riders who have placed 1st through 8th in any National Medal Class where the height of fences is 3'6" or higher. This includes, but is not limited to: USEF Hunt Seat Medal Class, ASPCA Horsemanship Class, Show Jumping Talent Search, W.I.S. Class, M and S Charles Owens Medal. The course shall consist of not less than eight obstacles 3'6" in height and must meet the requirements of USEF Rule EQ111.10. A Liverpool or water is prohibited. USEF tests 1-19. See above for class procedure.

The written exam will include questions on horse shows, horse care, equipment and the horse, and riding techniques. Sources which may be used will include the USEF Rule Book, George Morris' *Hunt Seat Equitation*, Paul Cronin's *Riding and Training the Sport Horse*, Jane Marshall Dillon's *A School for Young Riders*, and the Pony Club manuals.

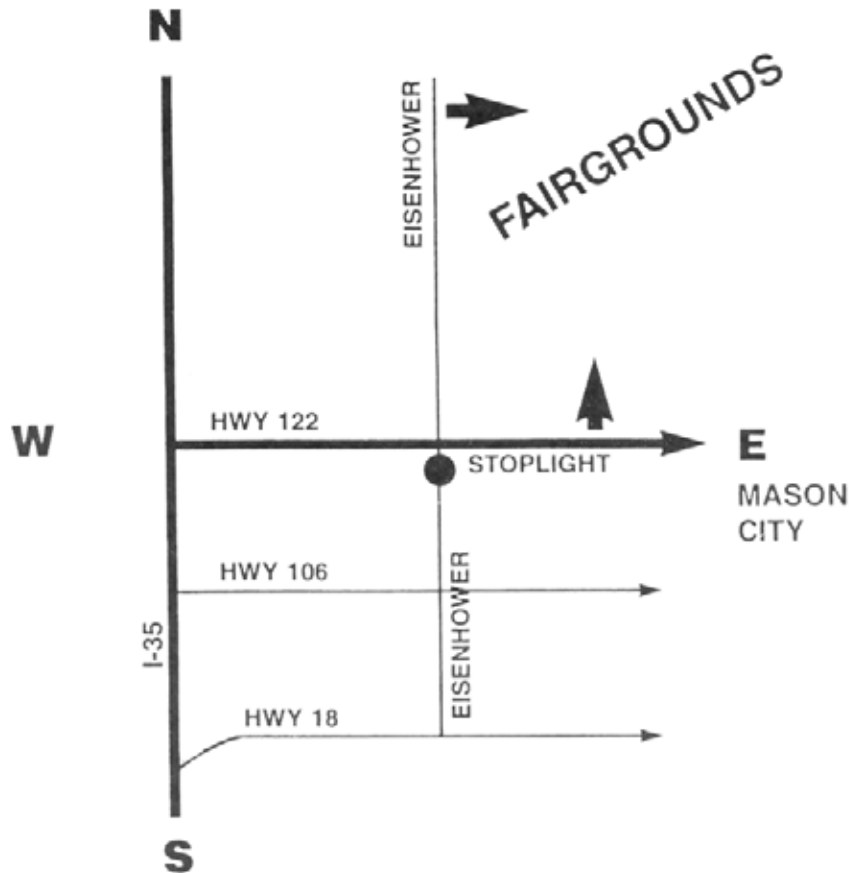
